📖 We learn this mitzvah from Parshas Vayikra: (ויקרא ה:ז-יח)

וְאִם נִפְשׁ כִּי תַחֲטָא
וְעָשְׂתָה אַחַת מִכָּל מִצְוֹת
ה' אֲשֶׁר לֹא תַעֲשִׂינָהּ וְלֹא
יָדַע וְאִשָּׁם וְנִשְׂא עֹוֹנוֹ:
וְהִבִּיא אֵיל תַּמִּים מִן הַצֹּאן
בְּעֶרְכָּךְ לְאִשָּׁם אֶל הַכֹּהֵן
וְכִפֹּר עָלָיו הַכֹּהֵן עַל שְׂגִגְתּוֹ
אֲשֶׁר שָׂגָג וְהוּא לֹא יָדַע

Today's *mitzvah* is to bring a *korban* called an *Asham Talui* if a person isn't sure if he did an *aveira* that would need him to bring a *Korban Chatas*.

 The details of this mitzvah are explained in Mishnayos & Gemara: *Mesechta Kerisus*

PEREK GIMMEL

There are many *halachos* about a person bringing *korbanos* for *aveiros*. One *halacha* is that two people cannot bring a *korban* together for their *aveiros*. If they do this, they need to

both bring a new one. They get money for this by selling the *korban* they brought together!

PEREK DALED AND PEREK HEY

In these *perakim*, we learn about a person who does many *aveiros* at one time. Does he

need to bring more than one *korban*?
