 We learn this mitzvah from Parshas Bechukosai: (ויקרא כזכור)

## לֹא יִקְדִישׁ אִישׁ אֶתוֹ

If we decided that a certain animal will be for a *Korban Asham*, we can't change it afterwards and bring it as a *Korban Chatas*! It has to be the SAME animal for the SAME *Korban*.

 The details of this mitzvah are explained in Mishnayos & Gemara: *Mesechta Temurah perek Hey*

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 This mitzvah includes all of the halachos of *Tumas Meis*, and does not have a specific *posuk* we learn it from.

If someone becomes *tomei* with *Tumas Meis* (touching the body of a person who passed away), he needs to follow the *halachos* about what he is not allowed to do while he is *tomei*, and how he can become *tahor* again.

## Rambam: Hilchos Temurah, Hilchos Tumas Meis

### PEREK DALED

The Rambam teaches us what happens if an animal that is supposed to be a *Korban* or a *Temurah* has a baby.

The Rambam explains how a person can get *Tumah*.

This *perek* teaches us what can give *Tumas Meis*.
