 This mitzvah includes all of the halachos of Tumas Zavah, and does not have a specific posuk we learn it from.

Today's *mitzvah* is about a *Zavah* — a woman who has a specific health problem. This makes her *Tomei*, and there are lots of *halachos* about how she becomes *Tomei*, and what else she makes *Tomei*.

Rambam: Hilchos Metamei Mishkav U'Moshav

PEREK ZAYIN

In today's Rambam, we learn more about the kinds of *Tumah* where a PERSON makes other things *Tomei*!

This *perek* teaches us about "*Midras*" — that anywhere where someone with one of the kinds of "body" *Tumah* leans, sits, or rides, becomes an "*Av Hatumah*" ("very" *tomei*, so it can make many other things *Tomei* as well).

PEREK CHES

The Rambam explains what happens if one of these people move something, in lots of different ways. For example, do the things become *Tomei* if he moved it with a stick he is holding under his chin?

PEREK YUD

We learn what happens if one of these *Tomei* people bangs into something and makes it fall. We also learn about times when things get *Tumas Midras* because they MIGHT have become *Tomei*.
