Today's *mitzvah* is that a *kohen* is not allowed to become *tomei*, except for certain people in his family.

Rambam: Hilchos Aveil

PERAKIM TES, YUD, AND YUD-ALEF

In today's Rambam we learn that there are certain things we do after a person passes away, like saying *Mishnayos* or lighting a *yartzeit licht*.

Usually, only someone in the family does these things, but for a *Nosi* or a Rebbe, EVERYONE should do these things, because the Rebbe is like the Tatty for all Yidden.
