We learn this mitzvah from Parshas Emor: (ויקרא כג:ו)

בִּסְכַּת תֵּשְׁבוּ שִׁבְעַת יָמִים

In today's *Sefer Hamitzvos*, we learn one *mitzvah* about *Sukkos*: We need to live in the *Sukkah* on *Sukkos*.

This is one of the *mitzvos* that women do not need to keep.

PEREK GIMMEL

In this *perek* we finish learning the *halachos* of the *shofar*. We learn how to blow the *shofar*, including about the three kinds of sounds, *Tekiyah*, *Shevarim*, and *Teruah*.

PEREK DALED

We start learning the *halachos* of a *sukkah*. We learn the smallest and biggest size a *sukkah* can be, and the many different shapes it can have! Did you know that a round *sukkah* is kosher?

PEREK HEY

This *perek* teaches us the *halachos* about *sechach*, the most important part of the *sukkah*. We learn what kosher *sechach* is, and what happens if non-kosher *sechach* got mixed into it!

One *halacha* in this *perek* is that you need to put on the *sechach* yourself. So if you see a haystack and you make a hole in it so you can crawl inside so that the *sechach* is already there, that's not a kosher *sukkah*!
