In today's *Sefer Hamitzvos* we learn the same *mitzvah* as yesterday again — that a person is not allowed to act like he is married to a woman without first doing the *mitzvah* of *Kiddushin*, getting married according to Torah.

## Rambam: Hilchos Ishus

### PERAKIM YUD-ALEF, YUD-BEIS, AND YUD-GIMMEL

In today's Rambam, we learn about things a husband has to do for his wife. One *halacha* is that he has to buy her new clothes every year.

We also learn about moving: One *halacha* is that if the husband says that the neighbors are

not good people, he can make his wife move even if she doesn't want to. And the same is for her — if she thinks the neighbors aren't good people, she can make them both move away.
