In today's *Sefer Hamitzvos*, we learn the *mitzvah* that a man is not allowed to hold back certain things from his wife — he has to take care of her food and clothes, and spend certain times with her.

## Rambam: Hilchos Ishus

### PERAKIM YUD-DALED, TES-VOV, AND TES-ZAYIN

In today's Rambam, we learn many *halachos* about what a husband has to do for his wife. He has to pay for a doctor if *chas veshalom* she gets sick, and if she gets put into jail he has to pay money to take her out of jail. He should

talk to her nicely, and not get angry.

We also learn what a wife has to do for her husband: The Rambam says that she should have a lot of *kavod* for him, and do her best to do things the way he likes.
