Rambam: Hilchos Ishus

PERAKIM CHOF-GIMMEL, CHOF-DALED, AND CHOF-HEY

In today's Rambam, the last three *perakim* of *Hilchos Ishus*, we learn about a woman who doesn't listen to her husband when he tells her not to spend time by herself with a certain man. She is called a *Sotah*, and has to drink bitter water that tests her to see if she did something wrong. We will learn all the

halachos about this IY"YH in *Hilchos Sotah*, later in Rambam.

Yidden are like Hashem's wife. Hashem gave us *mitzvos*, and doesn't want us to act in a different way. We need to make sure we keep the Torah and *mitzvos* so that we can get all of the *brachos* from Hashem!
