 We learn this mitzvah from Parshas Ki Seitzei: (דברים כד:ד)

וְכָתַב לָהּ סֵפֶר כְּרִיתֹת
וְנָתַן בְּיָדָהּ

Today's *Sefer Hamitzvos* is the same as yesterday's — that if a man and woman can't stay married, the husband has to give his wife a *get*. (A *get* is a paper that shows that they are not married anymore.)

 The details of this mitzvah are explained in Mishnayos & Gemara: **Mesechta Gitin**

Rambam: Hilchos Girushin

PERAKIM DALED, HEY, AND VOV

Today in Rambam we learn about the *get* and how a person can write it. A *get* can't be written with invisible ink or juice that will disappear! It's better not to write a *get* with a pencil, because it can be erased.

We also learn about how someone can give a *get*. A *get* has to be given to the woman. We learn the *halachos* if he throws her the *get*, or gives it to someone else to give to her.
