 We learn this mitzvah from Parshas Ki Seitzei: (דברים כ"ד)

לֹא יוּכַל בְּעֵלְהָ הָרֵאשׁוֹן
אֲשֶׁר שָׁלַחַהּ
לָשׁוּב לְקַחְתָּהּ

In today's *Sefer Hamitzvos* we again learn that if a husband and wife decide that they can't be married anymore, they can change their minds unless the woman gets married to someone else in between. Once she gets married to another person, she can never get married to her first husband again.

In today's Rambam we learn the *halachos* of a *get* with conditions.

We also learn more *halachos* about *shlichus* — if the husband made someone a *shliach* to

bring the *get*. The *shliach* needs to do everything exactly the way he was told. Only if he follows his instructions is the *shlichus* a good *shlichus*.
