📖 We learn this mitzvah from Parshas Ki Seitzei: (דברים כ"ד)

לֹא יוּכַל בְּעֵלָהּ הָרֵאשׁוֹן
אֲשֶׁר שִׁלְחָהּ
לָשׁוּב לְקַחְתָּהּ

In today's *Sefer Hamitzvos* we again learn that if a husband and wife decide that they can't be married anymore, they can change their minds unless the woman gets married to someone else in between. Once she gets married to another person, she can never get married to her first husband again.
